



Born on September 16, 1875 in Salàs de Pallars, Lleida, Spain. Priest. Member of the Sons of the Holy Family; worked as secretary for his Institute. Publisher of their magazine. Wrote the first biography of Saint Josep Manyanet-y-Vives. Catechist and spiritual director for young people, working closely with those with a call to religious life. Promoted devotion to the Holy Family as a way for families to stay together. Arrested on 19 April 1937 by anti-Church forces. One of the Martyrs of the Spanish Civil War. Died on May 3, 1937 in Montcada, Barcelona, Spain. His body was thrown into a common grave.
